International Admissions

For the 2017-18 school year, International students must possess a high level of English for acceptance in the diploma program.

The following forms are required for admissions:

1. Application packet
2. Immunization record
3. Official school transcripts in English
4. Income statement certified by a bank
5. Copy of Passport

After all paperwork has been received, a video interview followed by an administrative team meeting will complete the decision on the student's acceptance. The time frame for the admissions process is about four weeks.

Courses

International students must possess a high English level to take AP classes. Below is a general sequence of high school courses offered. Courses are subject to change according to student interest and enrollment.
