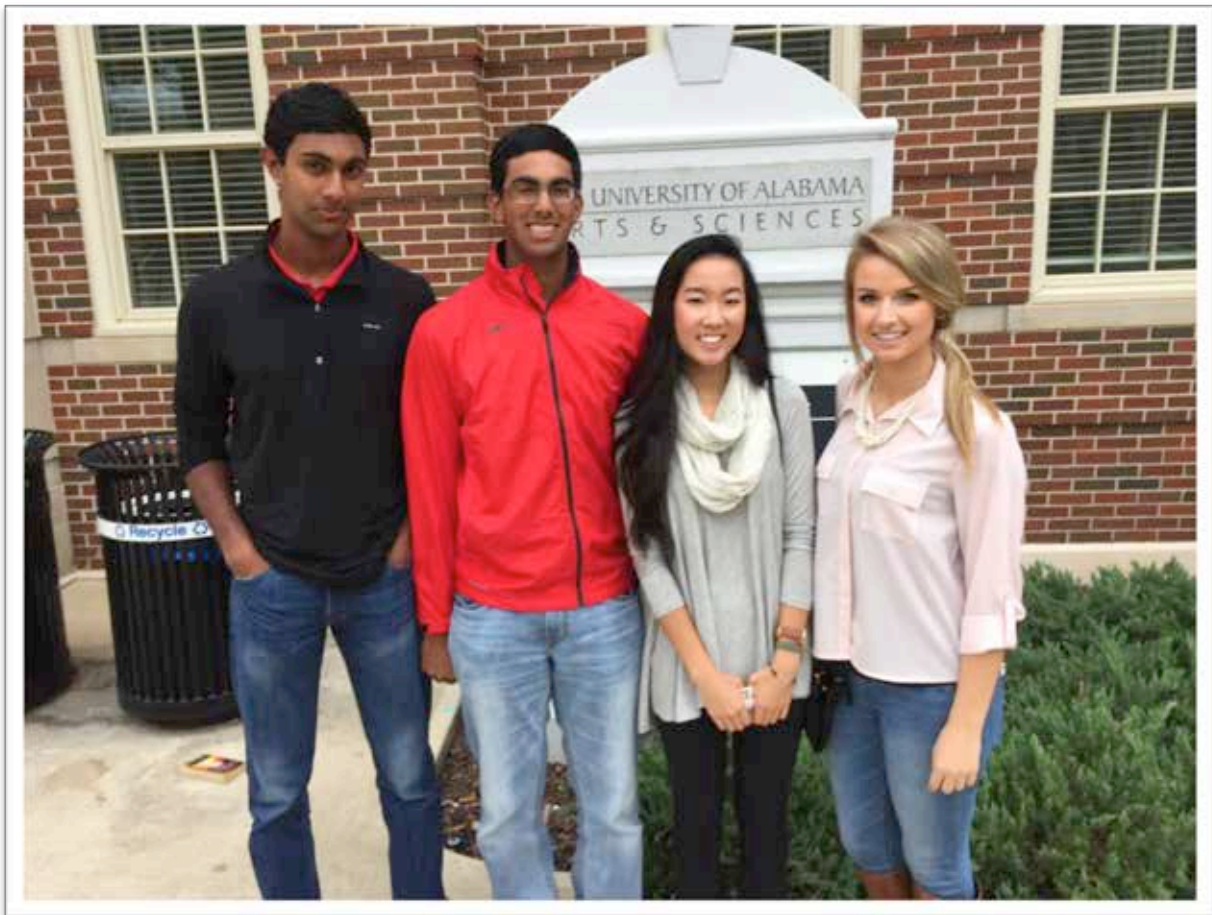

Springwood Scholars Bowl team placed third in the William Rufus King Invitational

The Springwood Scholars Bowl team placed third in the William Rufus King Invitational held Saturday on the campus of the University of Alabama in Tuscaloosa. The team scored wins over Lamp B (580-15), Tate of Pensacola, FL (460-115), West Point B (485-50), LAMP A (310-240), Hewitt-Trussville (505-110), Good Hope (465-55), and Ramsay (355-165). The team's two losses came to first place Hoover (290-295), and second place West Point A (270-325). Venu Reddy, son of Usha and Dr. Kris Reddy of Lanett, AL, was recognized as the individual high scorer of the tournament averaging an incredible 127 points per game. Thirteen schools from Alabama and Florida participated in the event. The team's next tournament will be October 20th at Southern Union in Wadley, AL.
