Springwood School 4th-6th Duke TIP Qualifiers

The Duke University Talent Identification Program (Duke TIP) recently announced the 24th annual 4th – 6th Grade Talent Search winners. Twelve students in 4th, 5th, and 6th grades at Springwood School qualified for recognition in the Duke University Talent Identification Program. In order to qualify, students must have scored 95% or higher in one major portion of the standardized test that was administered last spring.

The Duke Tip Search is conducted throughout a 16-state area. As a nonprofit organization, Duke TIP has two primary goals: to help academically talented students achieve success and to help schools meet the academic, social, and emotional needs of gifted children. Duke TIP works with students, their families, and educators to identify, recognize, challenge, engage, and help students reach their highest potential. Since 1980 Duke Tip has supported more than 2.5 million gifted students and their families with educational programs opening the door to opportunities for students to become involved in annual writing and illustration contests, bimonthly book clubs, online lessons and more.
