Springwood Scholars Bowl team placed 5th in the prestigious Hoover Invitational Tournament

The Springwood Scholars Bowl team placed 5th in the prestigious Hoover Invitational Tournament on Saturday Nov. 21st. The tournament featured the strongest field in Alabama scholars bowl history with elite teams representing four southeastern states. The 24 teams were divided into 4 pools with the top 16 teams advancing to the playoffs. Springwood finished second in their pool (5-1) scoring wins over Mountain Brook A (385-170), Woodford County B of Kentucky (400-145), Altamont School (300-90), Hewitt-Trussville (335-150), and Evangel Classical Christian (330-100). The teams only loss came to eventual champion Dorman A from Spartanburg, South Carolina (110-545). Dorman is ranked in the top ten nationally. In the playoffs Springwood defeated Oak Mountain of Birmingham (320-70) before losing to Dorman A in the quarter-finals (140-555). Springwood junior Venu Reddy was honored as the second highest scorer of the tournament. The team's next tournament will be December 12th at Buckhorn High School in New Market, AL.
