Springwood Scholars 2nd out of 24 teams in the Snead State Community College Tournament

The Springwood Scholars team placed second out of 24 teams in the Snead State Community College Tournament held Friday in Boaz, AL. The Snead State Tournament is the longest running scholars bowl event in the United States (45 consecutive years). The Wildcats were undefeated in pool play defeating St. Bernard "A" (430-90), Westbrook (420-150), Cleveland (400-120), Sand Rock (460-120), and St. Bernard "B" (310-120). In the playoffs Springwood defeated Susan Moore in the quarterfinals (610-0) and West Point "A" in the semifinals (330-280). In the championship match the Wildcats lost a close match to the largest high school in Alabama, Hoover High School (270-400). For the second year in a row Springwood senior Venu Reddy was honored as the MVP of the tournament. Springwood's final regular season match before Nationals will be the West Point Invitational on May 13th in Cullman, AL.
