Mrs. Sarah Lewis will teach mathematics at Springwood. She graduated from the University of Houston in Houston, TX with a Bachelor of Science degree in Interdisciplinary Studies (Mathematics) and did her student teaching at Arnold Middle School in Cypress, TX. Sarah and her husband, Nathan, moved to West Point in the fall of 2012 when Nathan became the Youth Minister at Spring Road Church in Lanett. Mrs. Lewis has been most recently employed by Point University as Registrar Assistant. Additionally, she has served as a math tutor, and a substitute teacher.
